- Shop from the easyfundraising website, search for the retailer you'd like to shop with and click through to the retailer to make your purchase. This tells the retailer you came from easyfundraising. The price is exactly the same as if you'd visited the retailer directly.
- Get a donation after you've made your purchase, the retailer will give you a cash reward that easyfundraising turn into a donation for Beeston Hall School Cromer. All donations will go towards the School's chosen charities
