RE: Covid-19 update

It was only a matter of time, I suppose, but sadly we have had a positive Covid-19 result with a member of the parent body. This means that the children (one in school, one already at home) are now in isolation and currently waiting for tests and results.

Should the tests of both children come back negative we proceed as normal. This we hope for. Should a test come back positive for the younger day child (Year 3), sadly she and all in her bubble will need to be at home, self-isolating, for 14 days. Should a positive test come back for the older boarding child (Year 8), all those in his bubble will need to begin a 14-day period of self-isolation, either at home or in our quarantine area in Dets.

In both cases, the Beeston provision will switch over to remote learning from the day after a positive test is confirmed and the actions above taken.
