

CURRICULUM GRID

English:

6.1 SAW Pupils will read the novel *Journey to the River Sea* by Eva Ibbotson.
6.1 NW Pupils will read a play adapted from the novel *Carrie's War*.

History:

Over the course of the Summer Term, the children will learn about Stephen and Matilda and the story of Thomas Becket and Henry II.

Latin: Consolidating Level 1 syllabus and moving on to Level 2, introducing the future and pluperfect tenses, and 3rd declension nouns.

Maths:

This term, the students will be looking at a variety of topics. The upper set will be working on topics including percentages, probability and averages, whilst the other set will commence work on algebra as well as exploring decimals and area further.

Geography:

We will undertake enquires inside and outside the classroom to develop understanding of how geological processes shape our changing planet and how forces deep within the Earth have powered the formation of huge mountains and deep trenches.

Computing:

This term in computing we will learn about broadcasting and how to make custom scratch blocks. We will then use this to create a quiz.

Art:

We will be learning about the rules of perspective, creating their own street scenes using these rules. They will explore ink and water colour together, adding vibrant colours to their final scenes.

Design Technology:

BOOKENDS – This Resistant Materials project is concerned primarily with woodwork, using different types of wood, tools and appropriate finishing techniques, pupils will design and make their own set of bookends.

Music:

are looking at the elements of Rock music and exploring a variety of bands and styles throughout the 20th century - modern day. They will also be performing and learning some of their favourite rock songs!

Science: This term we will be looking at the behaviour of light, how it travels, creates shadows and the basics of how we see. We will then move on to look at the properties of materials, consider how they respond to temperature and their insulating properties. We will learn about acids and alkalis and how we can use indicators to detect them. Finally we will look at electricity and in particular series circuits, circuit diagrams, the different components of circuits and electrical symbols.

PE:

Pupils will be learning a carousel of sports in PE including athletics (100, 200, 800, 1,500m running, high jump, long jump and hurdles), "Green Tennis" and swimming. In Games pupils will continue to develop their skills of cricket, learning batting, bowling and fielding techniques. They will also be introduced to new athletics skills, including shot-putt, discus and javelin on a Thursday afternoon.

R.S:

This term in Year 6 the pupils will be learning about Buddhism. Their studies will include topics such as the life of the Buddha, beliefs, places of worship, the life of a monk and The Dalai Lama.

French:

This term we will continue with the topic of clothes and fashion, where we will be describing clothes, styles and outfits depending on different situations. We will then move on to the topic of health and learn the vocabulary for parts of the body, revise how to say how I am feeling, as well as what is wrong when I am not well. Set 1 will also look at a range of idioms and expressions that use 'avoir' and 'être'. We will also be preparing pupils for a short speaking assessment based on the Year 6 Speaking Progression Questions.
